## **Press Conferences**

No press conferences are scheduled at the media centre after the races. Journalists will have the opportunity to conduct interviews directly in the mixed zone. Athletes will stop for the necessary time.

## **Media parking**

Accredited media with a valid pass will have access to the garage of the TH La Thuile - Hotel Planibel complex, which is directly connected to the building housing the main media centre and accreditation centre. However, it is recommended to use the parking facilities of the hotels where you are staying and to move around on foot.

# Photographers' Access to the Slope

Access to the slope is regulated by FIS and assigned based on priority lists. The authorised photographers' armbands will be distributed by Alessandro Trovati, the official photographers' coordinator. All accredited photographers will have access to the reserved area in the mixed zone.

Crampons are mandatory to access the slope.

## **Public Ceremonies**

The public bib draw and official awards ceremony will take place in the square adjacent to the main media centre. A designated media working area will be reserved below the stage. Access will be granted only with valid accreditation.

# **Reaching the Start Area**

From the main media centre, two lift systems are required to reach the downhill start area. From the village, it is possible to take the Les Suches cable car or the Bosco Express chairlift, then continue with the Chalet Express chairlift to reach the downhill start. Only one lift is needed to reach the super-G start.
